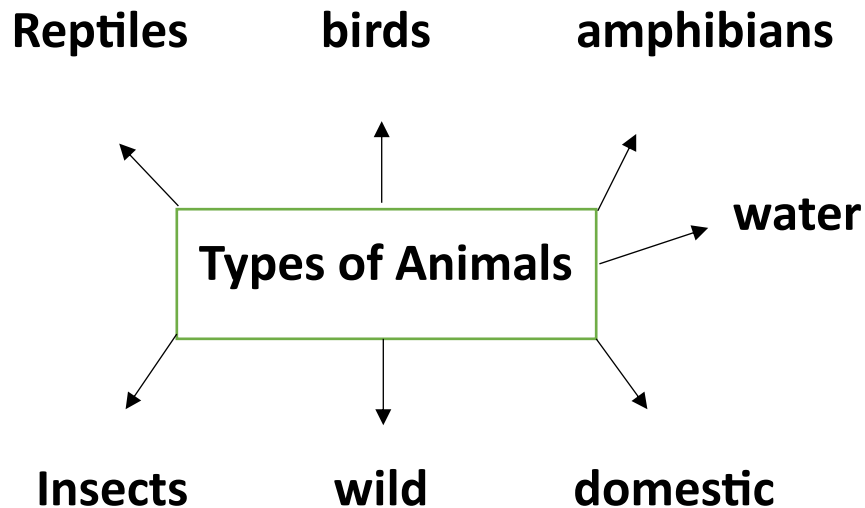

## **\*Defines**

- 1. Amphibians-** Some animals live both on land and in water are called amphibians. e.g.- crocodile, frog
- 2. Herbivores-** Some animals only eat plants are called herbivores. e.g.- cow, elephant, deer
- 3. Omnivores-** Some animals that eat both plants and flesh of other animals are called omnivores. e.g.- bear, crow, dog
- 4. Carnivores-** Some animals only eat flesh of other animals are called carnivores. e.g. lion, cheetah
- 5. Scavengers-** Some animals that eat flesh of dead animals are called scavengers. e.g. vulture, eagle
