A. Arrange these words to form sentences. Begin each sentence with a *capital letter*. Put a *question mark (?)* or *full stop (.)* at the end.

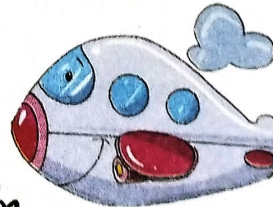
