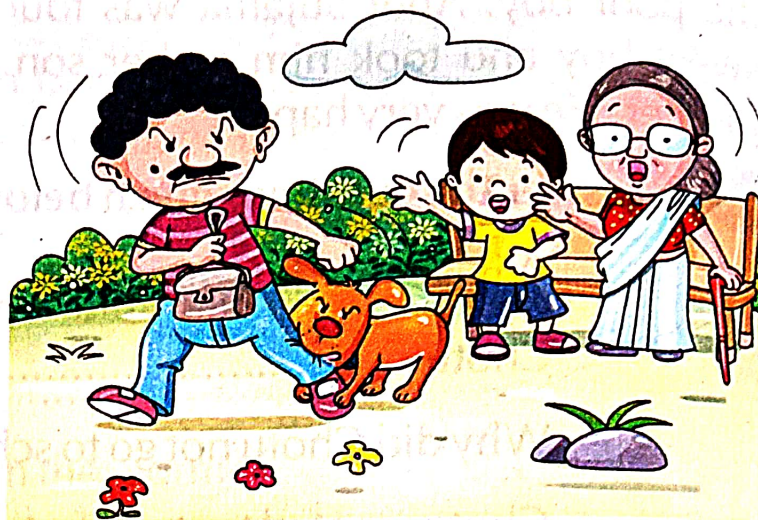


Read the story given here.
