A word that is used in place of a noun is called a pronoun.

Examples:

he, she, it, me, I, you, they, we etc.

He → Man, boy (male)

She → Woman, girl (female)

It → Animal, place, thing

I, me, my → Myself

Singular Pronouns

he, my, she, you, it, I, me

Plural Pronouns

we, they, you
