Tenses are the verbs or action words that tells us the time of an action.

Tenses are of 3 main kinds.

- 1. Past tense → yesterday
- 2. Present tense \rightarrow today
- 3. Future tense → tomorrow
- 1. Past tense An action that already took place. Eg I **played** cricket.
- 2. Present tense An action that is happening. Eg I <u>play</u> cricket.
- 3. Future tense An action that will happen later. Eg I <u>will play</u> cricket.
