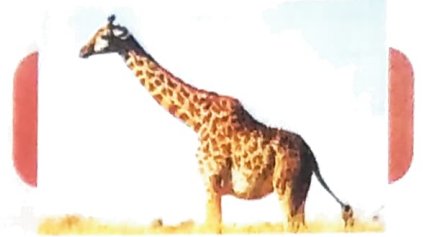
This is a tall and heavy animal. It has a long trunk and a pair of tusks.
