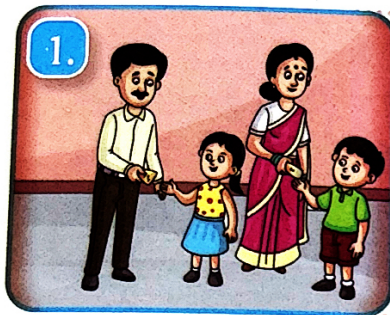


20 Money Smart

We all know that money is used to buy the things we need. Our parents work hard and earn money. So, we must use money wisely and also learn how to save it.

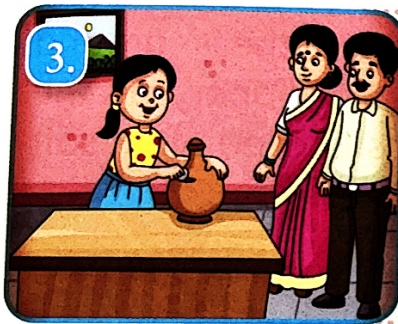

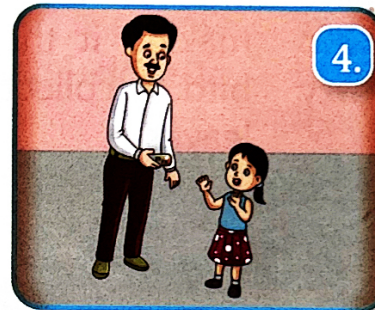
1. Harish and Cindy's parents give them money on some occasions.

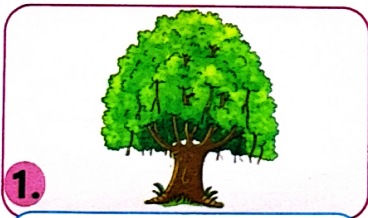

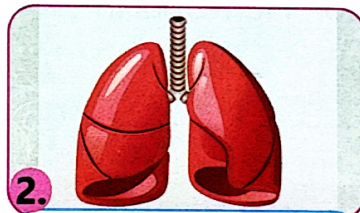

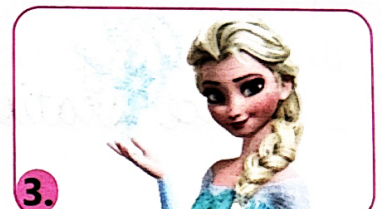
