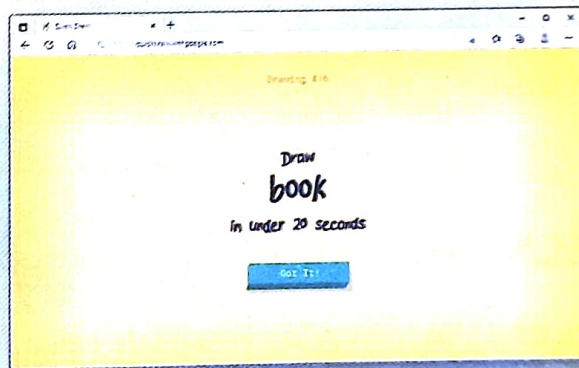
A. Open Paint and draw:
