2. How does the skeleton help us?

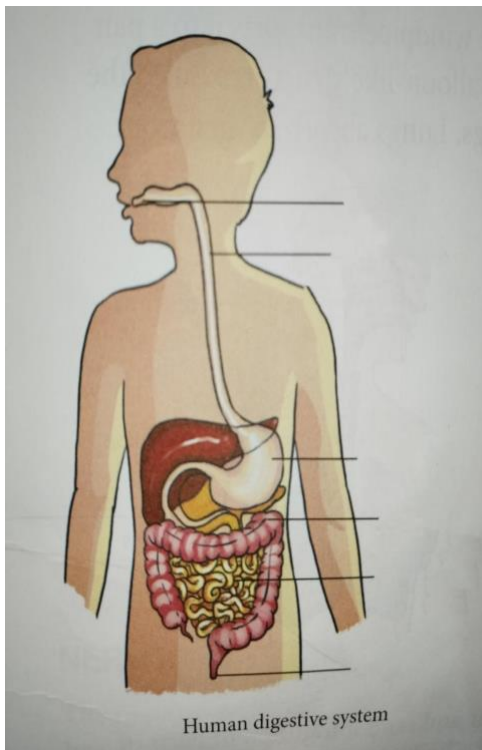
Ans. The skeleton help us in many ways -:

Ans. Blood helps to transport food and oxygen in our body. Heart pumps the blood and blood vessels carry the blood to all parts of the body .

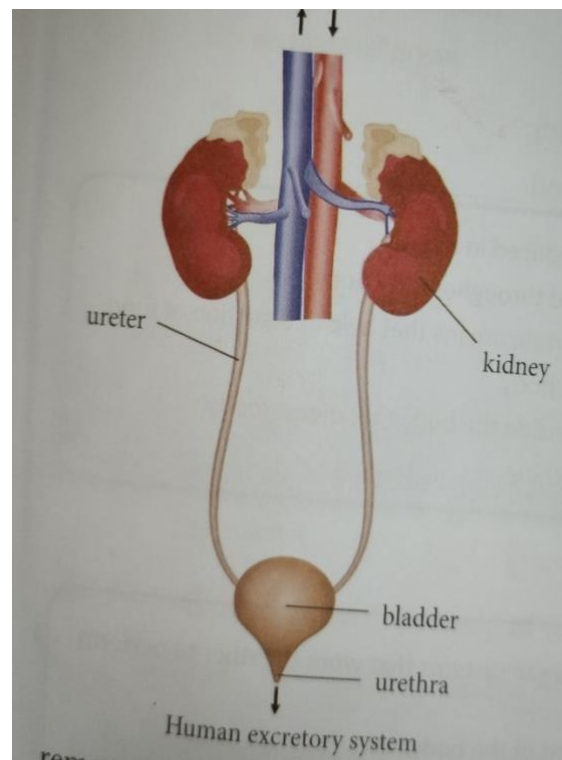
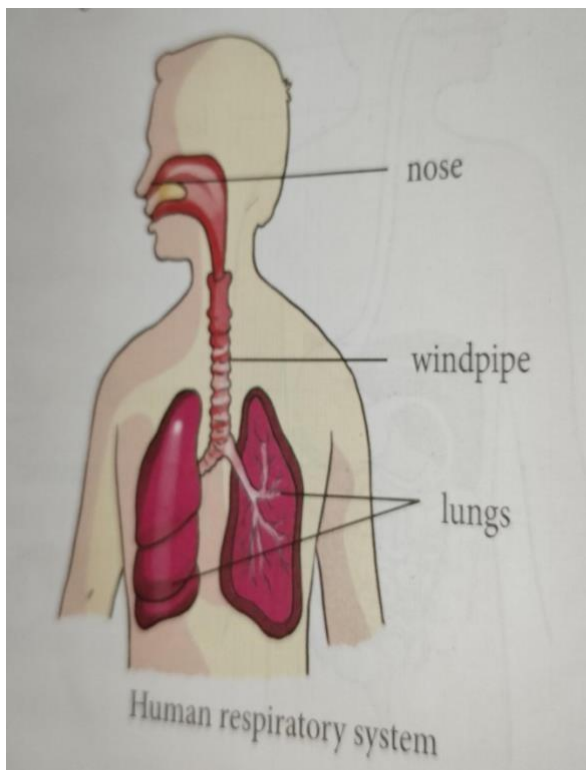
