

<u>ANS3</u>. Slide layout is the formatting and positioning of the placeholder boxes. There are 9 types of slide layouts available in PowerPoint.

<u>ANS4</u>. The slide sorter view shows the miniature version of all slides. Reading view is used when you want to view a presentation not in full screen but in a window.
