Ans- Early man started building mud houses with thatched roofs close together. Groups of these houses slowly took the form of villages.

(b) List the animals which early human began to domesticate for the first time.

Ans- The animals which early human began to domesticate for the first time are dogs, sheep, goats and cattle.

(c) Where did the farmers and herders live in the Neolithic Age?

Ans- The farmers and herders lived in groups called tribes. A tribe is a group of families related to each other and living together in small settlements or villages.

Ans- i) These tools were much sharper and better polished and had wooden handles.

ii) Hooks, arrow head, awls, spatulas and needles were essential tools used in fishing, hunting, leather working, basketry, weaving and pottery.

Ans- The uses of pottery to early human are -

- i) To store food
- ii) Pots were also used for cooking food rice, lentils, etc.

Ans- i) Invention of the wheel is regarded as the first technological revolution of mankind.

ii) Stones rolling down the mountain slopes or big logs of wood rolling down by applying physical force might have given early human the idea of making wheels.

Ans- i) Animals that were reared could be used as stored food because they provide milk and meat.

- ii) Animals were used for ploughing fields and transportation.
- iii) Man provided food and security to herds of animals he did not have to wander from place to place in search of food.

Ans- i) Early man started building mud houses with thatched roofs close together.

(e) How do we know that early humans believed in life after death?

Ans- i) They started burying the dead along with the daily necessities of life such as pottery, weapons and food items.

ii) Burial sites have also been found at Mehrgarh. Bones of animals and charred grains are found.
