 - Supply of fresh drinking water.
 - To provide vegetable markets, food grain markets and other consumer goods.
 - To supply electricity.
 - To grow plants and trees along the roadside for better environment.
 - To maintain records of births and deaths and issue certificate for the same.
 - Opening of primary and secondary schools for children and to appoint teachers in those schools.
 - Maintaining a firefighting service and checking of illegal trades.
- (d) The optional functions of a Municipal Corporation and Municipality are:-
 - Development of gardens and parks to keep citizen healthy and fit.
 - Construction and maintenance of children's homes, orphanages, night-shelters, rest-houses, old-age homes etc.
 - Development of zoo, museums, picnic spots, children parks and toy houses.
 - Providing cheap and efficient transport facilities.
 - Construction of toilets and bathrooms in the slums and other states.
