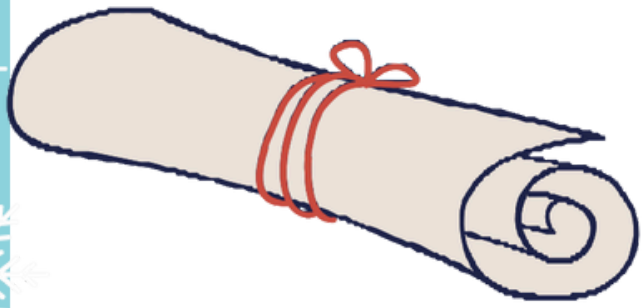
WINTER VACATION:-
