

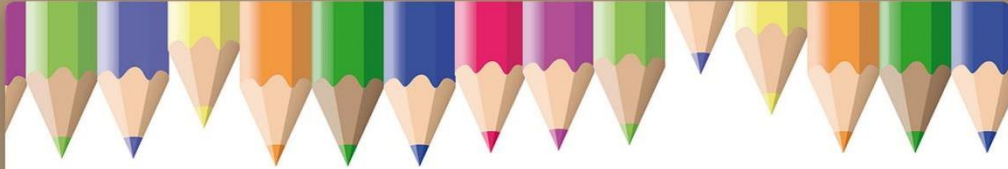

Holidays Homework carries marks; hence submission of work post vacation is Compulsory for all students.

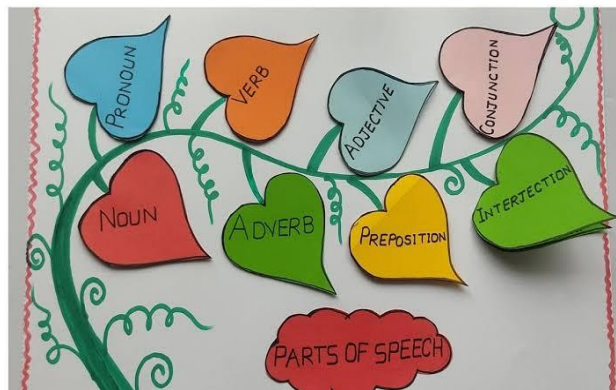
Instructions :

Fruits and raw vegetables such as Celery, Tomatoes, Carrots, Cucumber, Broccoli etc. are the best alternative to high- energy snacks. In addition to being lower in energy, they provide vitamins and minerals and fibres for maintaining healthy musculature of alimentary canal.
